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

POST GRADUATION PLANS

Of the 441 Economics majors who graduated, data is available for 389. Of this number, 80% accepted employment, 17% were attending graduate school, and 3% were still looking or not seeking employment.

AVERAGE SALARY


Out of 142 students who reported salary, the average annual base salary is \$76,840. The median annual base salary is \$77,500.


AVERAGE SIGNING

GRADUATE SCHOOL DISCIPLINES



187 out of 441 surveyed Economics majors reported their data through UVA's First Destination Survey. For those who did not, the ECO undertook research to locate their post-graduation information through LinkedIn, Handshake, and email correspondence. We are reporting on information for 389 graduates (80%) in total. Employer information and job function were found for 327 of these graduates.




Distribution of Employment by Industry





Values represent a percentage of the 129 graduates whose Job Industry was catergorized as Financial Services.







Distribution of Bonuses



Offer/Accept Timeline


